When dealing with child custody...

- ◆ The average cost of a custody case can range anywhere from **\$2,000 to \$40,000**.
- ◆ The U.S. has **12.9 million custodial parents**.
- ◆ **49.4%** of all custodial parents had a court order or an agreement to receive financial support from the noncustodial parent.
- ◆ Most Texas custodial fathers get the child **33% of the time**.
- ◆ **4 out of 5** custodial parents are mothers.
