



## 2026 Participating Attorney Fee Schedule: Independent Secure Plan

The 2026 Fee Schedule will be exclusively valid and effective where Covered Legal Services are begun on or after January 1, 2026. Where the Insured's policy has renewed such that the benefits under the renewed policy match the benefits on this Fee Schedule or the Insured has applied and paid for a policy whose benefits match the benefits on this Fee Schedule.

### Plan Type and Policy

Texas Legal offers this policy to individuals who are not employed or associated with a group. This Policy is:

- (1) a comprehensive plan offered to individuals, called the "Secure" plan

This Fee Schedule is structured to provide a clear overview of what benefits are offered under this plan. Please confirm the Insured's plan type and policy to ensure all references and communications align with the applicable fee schedule governing their coverage.

### Authorization Requirements

Texas Legal requires Participating Attorneys to contact Texas Legal to obtain authorization prior to rendering any Covered Legal Services to an Insured. Securing authorization for Covered Legal Services confirms the availability of coverage for a specific legal matter under the relevant policy and for the specific Insured. It's important to note claims submitted for payment under Covered Legal Services will be denied if the required authorization was not obtained before rendering services. Legal Services, including all offense dates, petitions with associated filing dates, must arise or be filed on or after the Insured's effective date of coverage.

**Authorization Submission Method:** Participating Attorneys or their staff are required to submit an authorization request for Covered Legal Services using one of the methods below:

### Claim Submission Requirements

The requirements below outline the process and expectations for submitting claims for Covered Legal Services to Texas Legal. It's important for Participating Attorneys and their staff to adhere to these guidelines to ensure their claims are considered for payment.

**Claim Submission Method:** Participating Attorneys or their staff are required to submit claims for Covered Legal Services using one of the methods below:

- Online Claim Form <https://texaslegal.org/attorneys/resource-center/> Password: **CL7500**

**Claim Form and Required Documentation:** All claim submissions must include a completed claim form with the appropriate billing codes, an authorization number, and the required documentation specified in the "Required Documentation" section of the Fee Schedule for each Covered Legal Service.

**Request for Additional Documentation:** Texas Legal staff may request additional documents to validate a claim. Texas Legal will make reasonable efforts to request necessary documentation for incomplete claims. However, if the required documentation is not received within five (5) days of the request, the claim will be denied.

**Withdrawal from Representation:** If a Participating Attorney withdraws from representing an Insured before completing the Covered Legal Services, they must file a motion to withdraw and receive a court order executed by the relevant Judge. A claim for Legal Services should be submitted following the procedures outlined in the Participating Attorney Agreement within 72 hours of withdrawal.

**Claim Submission Deadline:** All claim submissions are required to be submitted within 60 days after the last substantive legal services for the Covered Legal Service for which the claim is being made. Failure to meet this deadline will result in the claim being denied without consideration.

**Denied Claims:** Denials due to missing information or insufficient required documents may be resubmitted. The missing articles in addition to the claim form, "Required Documentation," and any other relevant documents as determined by Texas Legal must be submitted within 60 days of the date on the Remittance Notice or Notice of Denial. For all other denials refer to the "Appeal Process" section.

### Claim Adjudication Schedule

Claims are subject to adjudication within ten (10) business days from the date of receipt by Texas Legal. The issuance of payment by direct deposit or a notice of denial will be communicated by email within the same ten (10) business day timeframe. Although it is the customary practice to release payments and denial notices on Fridays, it is important to note that Texas Legal maintains the discretion to issue them on any business day within the specified ten (10) business days as previously mentioned.

## **Appeal Process**

Participating Attorneys have the right to submit an appeal for denied claims, additional compensation beyond benefit maximum for highly complex matters, or any disagreement with a decision made by Texas Legal Staff other than a final decision issued by the President of Texas Legal, using the process described in Section 18 of the Participating Attorney Agreement.

## **Flat Fee Benefits**

All flat fee payment amounts listed under the "Fee" section of the 2026 Fee Schedule are flat rate payments. Flat rate payments will be considered payment in full for rendering Covered Legal Services to a Texas Legal Insured, unless otherwise expressly noted in this Fee Schedule. Participating Attorneys may not bill a Texas Legal Insured in excess of this flat fee payment amount specified in the Fee Schedule, even if the Participating Attorney's customary rate is higher.

## **\*\* Hourly Benefits**

The hourly rate for Covered Legal Services is \$125 per hour. Each Covered Legal Service expressly noted as hourly in this Fee Schedule has a maximum number of hours covered by Texas Legal. Participating Attorneys may bill a Texas Legal Insured once the maximum number of hours listed under the Covered Legal Service have been exhausted. Participating Attorneys are required to provide the Participant or Insured a 25% discount from their customary rate for billable time beyond the benefit limits covered by Texas Legal.

## **Balance Billing**

Balance billing is allowed by the Participating Attorney for specifically identified Covered Legal Services, and only when the relevant following condition is met, either: (a) the maximum number of billed hours available per the Insured's policy have been reached by the Participating Attorney as stated in this Fee Schedule for the specific Covered Legal Service, or (b) where explicitly allowed in the Fee Schedule with regard to bankruptcy, the provision of bankruptcy legal services is in excess of the flat fee provided for such bankruptcy services in the corresponding Fee Schedule. Participating Attorney may enter into a written agreement with the Insured for payment of any further billed hours incurred for that Covered Legal Service, so long as the Participating Attorney offers a 25% discount from the customary rate the Participating Attorney charges for those services. Further billed hours for bankruptcy legal services are excepted from the 25% discount requirement.

## **Interim Billing**

Except where specifically provided herein, Texas Legal does not make interim payments for Covered Legal Services. Claims submitted for ongoing legal matters still in progress which have not been concluded and are not specifically excepted will be denied. Participating Attorneys must complete the Covered Legal Service and conclude the legal matter prior to submitting a claim for payment consideration. The only exception is expressly noted in this Fee Schedule and only applies under the Bankruptcy and General Legal Services benefits. Texas Legal requires the claim submission to fully comply with the Claim Submission Requirements as stated in the section "Claim Submission Requirements".

## **Out-of-Pocket Expenses/Incidental Fees**

Texas Legal policies provide coverage only for the Participating Attorney's billable time expressed either as a flat rate payment or an hourly benefit. In all instances, Texas Legal Participants or Insureds are responsible for any applicable Out-of-Pocket Expenses/Incidental Fees. Such expenses and fees are excluded from Covered Legal Services and include but are not limited to ancillary matter-related expenses like filing fees, court costs, reporter's fees, travel and other miscellaneous costs in any proceeding.

## **Recovery of Attorney's Fees & Return of Claim Payment**

In the event Participating Attorney is awarded attorney's fees and/or costs in a judgment, settlement, order, or similar process, and the fees and/or costs are received by the Participating Attorney, the Participating Attorney shall reimburse in accordance with the fees and costs awarded. For example, if costs are awarded which were paid by the Participant or Insured and/or Texas Legal, the Participating Attorney shall reimburse the Participant or Insured first and, if any award is remaining, reimburse Texas Legal up to the amount Texas Legal paid. After such reimbursements are made in full, the Participating Attorney may retain any balance of the fee awarded.

## **Definitions – The following definitions apply to this fee schedule:**

**Contested** – where the parties are adversarial and the attorney must negotiate with his/her client and the opposing party towards an agreement on at least one legal issue; or where the parties refuse to negotiate and a third party must decide on the behalf of both parties.

**Covered Legal Services** – are services specifically covered under the Participant's or Insured's policy benefits and/or not specifically excluded from coverage. Each Covered Legal Service can only be claimed once per plan year. With the exception of General Legal Services and Consultations, which may be claimed multiple times, however, is limited to the max allotted hours per the Participant's or Insured's Policy.

**Disposition of Court Proceedings** – evidence from the applicable court proving that a legal matter has concluded. As in the complete File Stamped Signed Order (ex: final orders in a Family Law case).

**Itemized Invoice** – invoice from the applicable attorney/firm with time itemized by date and fractions of an hour with detailed information that indicates the type of legal services rendered. Invoice must be consistent to billing code(s) and dates of service selected on claim form through the final resolution of the legal matter beyond the billable hours allotted for the hourly benefit authorized or shall be deemed incomplete and subject to the claim being denied.

**Non-Covered Services** – "Non-Covered Services" are either (1) legal services for a legal matter that is not covered and specifically excluded under a Participant's or Insured's policy or (2) the legal services provided after a Participating Attorney has exhausted the maximum possible benefit available for a Covered Legal Service that an effective and applicable Texas Legal Fee Schedule expressly states has limited coverage. Option (2) may only be provided at a 25% discount off of the Participating Attorney's normal and customary rate.

**Self-Propelled Vehicle** – a vehicle of any type, powered by any type of motor or engine, including, but not limited to, automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, motor bikes, boats, snowmobiles and airplanes.

**Trial** – the proceeding in court when the parties try their case beginning with the impaneling of a jury in a jury trial and with opening statements of the parties in a non-jury trial; trial does not include appearances on hearings, motions, pre-trial conferences, negotiated pleas, or appearances and continuance by a court.

**Uncontested** – where all parties have agreed in writing to the legal action, all required consents are attainable, and the legal action is not challenged.

## **SUMMARY OF CERTIFICATE/POLICY PROVISIONS**

All Certificates and Policies provide coverage only for legal actions instituted and legal advice or services sought while the Policyholder's Policy is in effect. The legal action or event giving rise to the legal issue must have occurred during the period the Insured's Policy is in effect. Texas Legal will pay for Covered Legal Services so long as the client remains an Insured on a Policy for which payment is current, up to the limits stated in the Policy. The date of alleged criminal offenses, file dates on suits, dates of alleged breach of warranty/contract/DTPA violation, and the date of death of an individual whose estate the Insured wishes to probate must occur during the time the Insured's Policy is in effect. The Participating Attorney must be employed during that same time.

Occurrences that arose prior to coverage being available, and are not specifically excluded from the policy, will be considered pre-existing and not covered under the Covered Legal Services; however, Insureds would be eligible for a 25% discount off a Participating Attorneys normal customary rate.

The descriptions of the Covered Legal Services and their limitations in this document are references to language in the Insured's Policy, and any endorsement attached thereto defining the Covered Legal Services available. In the case of discrepancy between the Policy, or any endorsement and this Fee Schedule regarding the definition, availability, or limitation of a Covered Legal service, the Policy under which the Insured is the beneficiary will control.

## **EXCLUSIONS**

The Policy does not provide coverage for:

1. Pre-existing matters as defined in the Policy.
2. Class actions, interventions, derivations, and amicus curiae filings.
3. Appeals of any kind whether from a court decision or administrative proceeding.
4. Plaintiff's lawsuits (outside of Family Law and Consumer Protection).
5. Intellectual property or business matters (any activity that produces revenue).
6. Motor-vehicle accident-related matters or any matter customarily handled on a contingency-fee basis.
7. Incidental costs such as filing fees, photocopies, postage, etc.
8. Modifications of bankruptcy payment plans and amendments to a bankruptcy post discharge.
9. Duplicated services previously claimed and in relation to the same legal matter.
10. The preparation of tax returns
11. Services which the participant is entitled to legal representation or reimbursement from any source other than Texas Legal, workers' compensation matters.
12. Legal matters to which Texas Legal deems frivolous, harassing, or unethical by the rules of professional conduct of the state in which the Attorney is licensed in.
13. Excluded legal matters or matters not identified as covered under the provisions of the policy.
14. Legal matters not involving the Participant or where a covered Eligible Person is covered, not involving that Eligible Person.
15. To anyone except the Policyholder for any legal services in which the interest of another party conflicts with the interest of the Policyholder.
16. Legal matter for Insureds related to the Participating Attorney or by any attorney or staff employed by or affiliated with a law firm in whole or in part by the Participating Attorney.
